Inclusive Early Childhood education

Age: 2.5 to 5 years

Our program integrates the Montessori philosophy with play-based learning, focusing on nurturing each child's natural curiosity and fostering holistic development. This approach encourages hands-on exploration, independence, and creativity in a structured yet flexible environment.

Learning outcomes

Inclusive Homeschooling

Primary Years (5-11yrs)

Development of core skills in subjects such as English, mathematics, and science.

Upper secondary Years (14-16yrs)

- Typically associated with the IGCSE exams.
- Students choose from a range of subjects, and their performance is assessed through coursework and external exams.
- The IGCSEs are widely recognized by universities and employers worldwide.

lower secondary Years (11-14yrs)

This level builds on the primary years, includes a broad curriculum with subjects like English, mathematics, science, and global perspectives.

High school Years (16-19yrs)

- Comprises the Cambridge International AS and A Levels.
- subject-specific and prepare students for university or further education.
- AS Levels (Advanced Subsidiary) are typically studied in the first year, and A Levels in the second year, offering in-depth knowledge in chosen subjects.

School schedule structure

Academic year :

- Starts January to december.
- Structured into three terms
- with short and long breaks.
- Our terms are partnered into 6 weeks of studying and 2 weeks break

School Days

- 5 days of school (Monday-Friday)
- 3 hours in class (basic subjects),
- 1 hour of breaks &
- 2hours of co-curricular activities after classes

Reporting Time:

Students will be divided into three:

- Group 1 (pre-school-primary)
- Group 2 (Secondary and advanced level)
- Group 3 (After school tutoring students)

Class time

- Group 1 : 7:30am to 11:30am
- Group 2 : 11:30 am-3:00pm
- Group 3: 2:30pm-7:00pm

Healthy and balanced diet Breakfast/ Lunch will be provided at the center

Class structure

class size:

Maximum of 5 students in a class

- 2: From mainstream backgrounds with no learning challenges.
- 2: With moderate learning challenges.
- 1 :With severe learning challenges.

Teacher student ratio

- We maintain a 1:5 teacher-student ratio for effective support.
- Students with severe challenges can receive a 1:1 or 1:2 ratio based on their specific needs.

Additional information

Available assistant teachers will move between classes to provide additional support to students and teachers as needed.

Safety

Surveillance Cameras

- we have installed security cameras in all the areas with student's reach to detect and provide record of events

Fire & Safety Drills

- Regular safety drills for both students and staff for proper responses in emergencies
- An updated emergency response plan

Child Protection Policies

- we have Establish and enforce child protection policies to safeguard students from abuse and neglect.

Security personnel

- Employ trained security personnel to monitor the premises and ensure a safe environment.
- Assist in monitoring student pick-up.

Medical station

we provide a well-stocked first aid kit and ensure that staff are trained in basic first aid.
